



Cheshire and Warrington Access to Finance and Grant Programme

<u>The Cheshire and Warrington Access to Finance and Grant programme</u> will support eligible small and medium-sized enterprises until December 2021 offering, grants that enable investment to help your business stimulate growth and achieve their ambitions.

Grants work out at approx.33% of your overall consultancy project, up to a maximum value of £15,000 grant. To help illustrate what funding you could get, please see the following illustrations:

Grants can be used for consultancy only, and for projects that will result in growth for the business. This could include, but is not restricted to:

Please take note of the following criteria:

- 1. This is a reimbursement grant, so you must have the cash flow to fund your project initially. You can claim back the grant after the project has been paid for by you.
- 2. This grant does not work retrospectively, only for projects once you receive a grant offer letter
- 3. Your business must be trading, i.e. not in pre-start stage.

The process for applying for the grant is as follows:

Stage 1: Enquiry into Blue Orchid, initial conversation about project ideas they are looking to implement and business need – enquire here: www.blueorchid.co.uk/a2fgrant

Stage 2: You will be sent an initial grant application form and intended outcomes and impact on your business

Stage 3: Once your application is reviewed and approved by our panel, you will complete a procurement exercise to seek at least 3 quotes for the work and choose their preferred supplier. We will help you with this

Stage 4: We will then issue a grant offer letter and at this point the project can commence and you can start paying your chosen suppliers

Stage 5: Once the project is completed and paid for, you will submit a claim form for 33% of the costs

Stage 6: Blue Orchid, on receipt of the claim form pay the grant to the client.

Eligibility:

- The business is trading address is in the Cheshire or Warrington LEP area
- The business has less than 249 FTE employees
- The business is independent (less than 25% owned by one or more external organisations
- The business has a turnover or balance sheet of less than Euro 50 million (approx. £35m) (collective if part owned)
- <u>Is not</u> a business in one of the following sectors: Fishery and aquaculture, Retail; Primary Production, Processing and marketing of agricultural products, Coal, steel and shipbuilding, Synthetic fibres production, Establishments providing generalised (school age) education, Banking and Finance Companies, Nuclear sector.
